Students will complete the components of the slides in order to understand their life is made up of many different stories.

Preparation:

- Download and save the Google Slide Activity to your drive.
- It might be beneficial if you create a couple of slides as an example.
- Decide if you want your students to present their presentation to the class. If you are remote, you can have students create a Loom or use Flipgrid to share their final product.

The Activity

Slides 2-5: Artifacts

- Students will find an artifact that is meaningful to them, take a picture of it, and write about its importance.
- I have had students share pictures of their baseball cleats, trophies, their first book, a watch from their grandfather.

Slide 6-8: People

- Students think about 3 people who are influential in their life.
- They will insert their image and reflect on their importance in their life through a series of 3 questions.

- Personally, I do not think they have to actually know the person in real life in order to consider them influential. This is your decision.

Slide 9-10: Challenges

- Students will write about 2 different challenges or struggles they have experienced in their life.
- They will reflect on how they grew, changed, and what they learned as a result of the challenge/struggle.

Slide 11: This is Me

- Students will insert a picture of themselves. I allow them to use a picture from any age.
- Students will write about what makes them unique.
