Preparation:

- If you are using the response cards for the Let's Try section, print and cut out before your lesson. Alternatively, you can have your students write on white boards or make their own response cards on index cards.
- The quest activities can be completed with a partner or independently. You can print the quest cards or add them to their google classroom for them to complete digitally.

Activity

 - 3: 2nd person- You

- Quest 2:
 - 1: 3rd person- Lori, She
 - 2: 1st person- I
 - 3: 2nd person- You
- Quest 3 and 4: Sentences will vary
- Quest 5:
 - 1. Omniscient: thoughts of both girl on street and barista
 - 2. Objective: no inner thoughts.
 - 3. Limited: just the thoughts of the girl
