

Adjective


Eager or quick to argue or fight

helps you make friends.







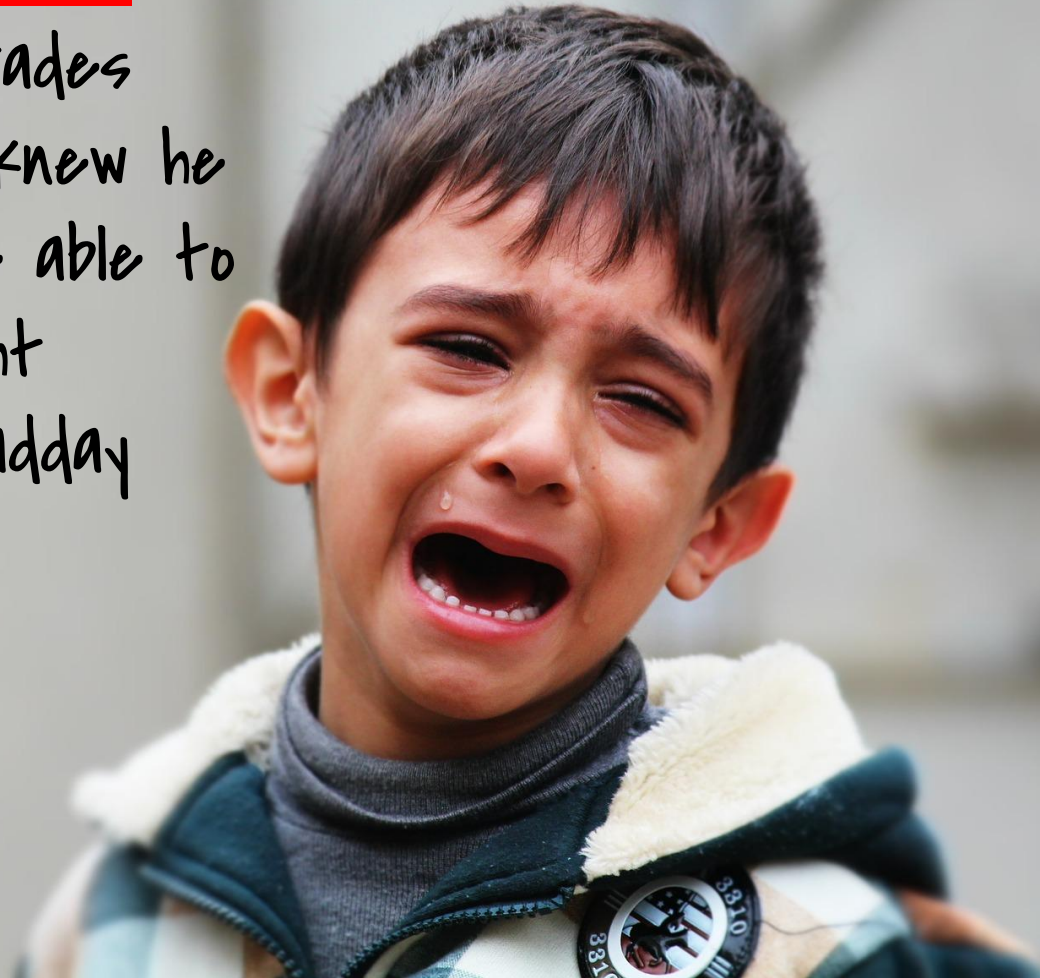
# Lament

Adjective


Delicious and savory
